I just finished reading a book by Francine Rivers entitled A Voice in the Wind. It is one of those books that you cannot put down. I took it with me everywhere in case I had a chance to read it for even just a few minutes. Thankfully, it is the first book of a trilogy so I am engrossed in the second book now. I will try my best so as not to ruin the story for you, just in case you decide to buy the book and have it take over your life as well.

The story takes place during the time just after the very first Easter story. Jesus had already been crucified, and Jerusalem is in the midst of being destroyed by the Romans. The main character in the book is a Christian girl, who was living in Jerusalem with her family when the Romans destroyed the city. Christians and Jews are being crucified by the thousands or taken as slaves. Many are taken to far away places and dispersed as they are sold as slaves or sent to become gladiators for Roman entertainment. The gladiators were prisoners who were brutally trained to fight and kill their opponent in the arena as Roman spectators cheered for blood. The Jewish slaves were brought and sold as property and lived with the constant threat of being sent to the arena to be devoured by lions or crucified if they did not please their masters. If you were discovered to be a Christian, it meant certain death.

As I read this book, it made me realize the circumstances in which the early Christians lived. They were considered a strange cult, hated, misunderstood, and thought to be a threat to the Roman way of life. They had to meet in secret places to worship with other Christians, always knowing they could be discovered and killed. I am so thankful for those early Christians who were so faithful to the Lord that they risked everything in order to spread the Good News. When I think about being a Christian in the modern world compared to those early years of Christianity, we certainly do not have the life threatening challenges of their time, and yet they were so willing to tell everyone the good news that CHRIST IS RISEN, HE IS RISEN INDEED. What do we have to fear?
