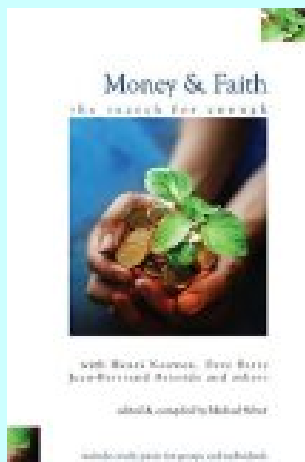
## Library Resource
