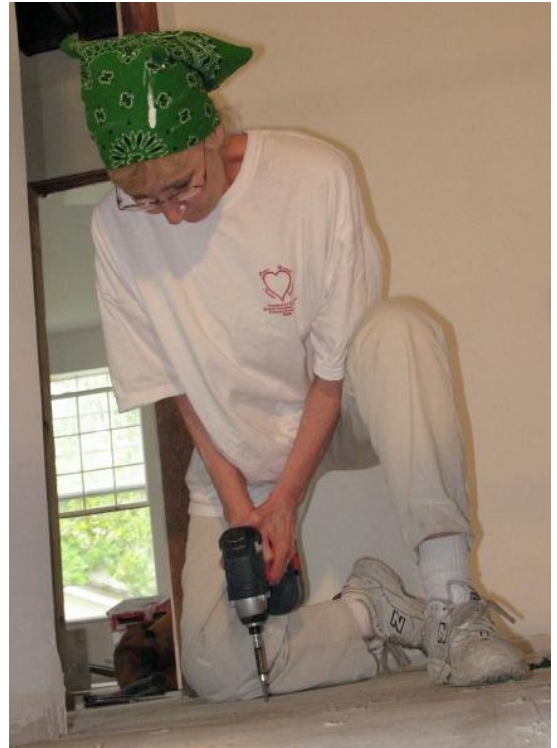
Mission Trip to Houma, Louisiana

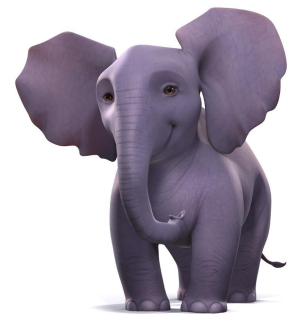

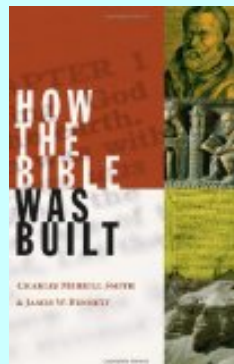
