Library Resource

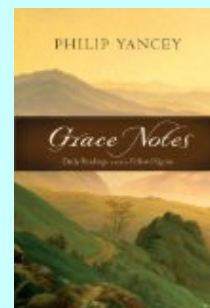
[Grace Notes: Daily Readings from a Fellow Pilgrim](#) by
