"A SIMPLE GIFT"

*"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden,
and I will give you rest.*

*Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me;
for I am meek and lowly of heart:
and ye shall find rest unto your souls."*

Matthew 11:28-29

Could it be that the most profound, inspirational, and life-changing gifts we receive come in the simplest forms, and usually are not even gift-wrapped? The verses above represent such a gift. In Handel's *Messiah* these verses are set to music in an aria, sung by a soprano. To me it is the most beautiful part of this magnificent musical composition. Handel is quoted as saying, "I did think I did see all Heaven before me, and the great God himself." Reportedly he was so inspired that he could barely get his notes onto paper fast enough (he wrote it over the course of two weeks). What a gift to the world! But, the gift of Jesus to the world topped that by far. Here he was, born of very humble circumstances, and in a stable no less. Yet the importance of this gift, the inspiration it generated, its life-changing significance, can hardly be described. What would the world be like without this gift? What kind of music would we be listening to? What amount of love, understanding, and forgiveness would live in the hearts of mankind? We surely would not have a Christmas.

The gift of Jesus Christ to the world is one that keeps on giving. It inspires us to continue to give to others, and in that sense to recognize, in each of us, what special gifts we too might have received from God and just how we have used those gifts to the glory of His handiwork. Handel certainly made the most of his God-given gifts. I often ask myself, what are mine, and how have I used them?
