"HOW HARD IT IS TO KNOW THAT GOD IS NEAR"

These words struck me profoundly as the choir began to learn a new carol, "Still Shining in the Holy Light," that will be premiered in honor of our Fiftieth Annual Lessons and Carols service on December 19. The late Rev. Albert Bayly, an English clergyman, wrote this powerful text with a beautiful musical setting by the contemporary American composer Glenn Rudolph.

*One starlit eastern night angelic heralds sang;
On trembling shepherds shone a light,
While heaven with music rang.
That holy night they knew that God was near.*

Our reaction today might be that we'd know that God was near too if heavenly lights and angelic music were all around us. In comparison it seems a lot more difficult today to know that God is near. This next verse speaks for most of us when, even as the holidays approach, we may find ourselves struggling to feel the peace and love we very much seek.

*But in the roar and glare of our world's crowded life;
The tumult, strain and anxious care,
Its fear and cruel strife:
How hard it is to know that God is near.*

But we see in the third verse that our situation today differs little from that first Christmas. The "crowd" was just as heedless of God's nearness as it is today.

*Yet when the Son of God lay in a manger bare,
A heedless crowd around him trod
And saw no glory there.
They knew it not, but God was very near.*

The final verse appeals to God to help us see God's presence in the face of Christ:

*Then grant us Lord the sight Thy glory now to trace,
Still shining in the Holy Light
Of Christ our Savior's face:
In Him to find Thy Presence here.*

May we at this time of year realize that God is behind each breath we breathe and behind the face of each of His children of whom Christ is the example who is "still shining in the holy light."
