Although a few years have passed, denying me the purchase of certainty, I recall it was either the second or third grade.

My first bad mark on an assignment and the clincher was having it sent home for my parents' signature. How could a seven or eight year-old escape that situation? Well, I tried. No, I didn't feed it to the dog but simply tossed it out the school bus window approximately 500 yards from our house. Yeah, that would do it. I just "lost" it. My parents would never know.

A few days later my father was out in the front yard mowing the grass. As he delightfully recalled on many occasions for years thereafter, it was a windy afternoon and square in his path was a piece of paper that brought our Snapper Comet riding mower to a halt. Can you imagine? No, I couldn't.

For the record, the C+ (or whatever the grade) assignment blew down a hill past eight houses dotting both sides of our street and, get this, even traversed a creek! In the realm of life's signal moments, the lesson learned that day struck like a lightning bolt: deceit, as far as I was concerned, was futile and best not even tried. I can still hear my father's gentle, almost teasing admonishment: 'ye sins shall find thee out!' I'll make no foolish attempt to convince anyone that was the last time I've waded into the waters of deception. My shortcomings and failures are innumerable but the opportunity provided through our faith to "come clean" through confession is one of the most powerfully liberating experiences of our human spiritual existence. We just have to ask. That's why, of all the elements of our church service, from the prelude to the benediction, the Prayer of Confession many times has a most positive effect of helping get me back on track after I've "gone wobbly."

Going wobbly is a most predictable result when loaded down with the bricks of sin, be they acts of commission or omission, but isn't it ironic how God, when approached with a humbled heart, removes the bricks from our conscience and puts them under our feet, effectively strengthening our foundations.

What joy to celebrate a loving God who offers all of us forgiveness and redemption through his most treasured blessing, Jesus Christ. Amen.
