**WITNESS**

What does it mean to witness for the church? It has different meanings for different people. Often to me the word witness has a negative connotation. I think about the people downtown handing out the "Have you been saved?" pamphlets. It seems I always try to give them a wide berth. I also think about how uncomfortable I am when someone rings my doorbell and wants to discuss religion. In fact, my neighbors and I have been known to send each other warning texts that someone is on the street. Although I think a lot of my discomfort in these situations has more to do with strangers being in my personal space than with the message itself.

I want to share my Christianity, but do it in a way that doesn't scare someone off. I share with non-church going friends about what an accepting congregation Westminster is and what a great experience Addison has had in the children's programs. I value the time spent teaching Sunday school and send my thanks to everyone that contributes. I am excited about the mission work we do in the community and abroad.

In my opinion, actions often speak much louder than words, though. A few months ago, my daughter started talking about how some girls at school had been cutting off their hair for Locks of Love on the school's morning show. She saw her peers cut their hair and also heard from another friend and her mom who have donated their hair multiple times. She decided that this was something she would like to do; so all spring we have measured hair until we got the needed 10 inches.

On Thursday morning, Brooks and I were at school listening to the guidance counselor talk about what a selfless act it was to give her hair, while another teacher cut off her ponytail. Of course I cried; it was one of my proudest moments as a mom.

What a great example of witnessing. Certainly someone else will see and make a decision to do the same or give in whatever way they can.

Remember this as you go into your week; actions affect us. Demonstrate to others what it means to be a Christian. Get caught in prayer. Mention what a great message you got from the sermon or Sunday school. Do a good deed. Share a smile. Witness for the Lord.
