MY NEIGHBORHOOD

I can safely say that Westminster Presbyterian Church has been part of my neighborhood since I was very young. In the summer of 1972, my family moved to Greenville, SC and that fall I attended Westminster Weekday School. Because of the weekday school, my family began worshipping at Westminster. In 1976, my family moved to Columbia, SC. We moved back to Greenville, SC in January 1978 and made our home on East Tallulah Drive, where my parents still live. We were welcomed back to the Westminster neighborhood with open arms. It was like we never left. Since we lived only a couple of blocks from the church we would sometimes walk to Sunday morning worship in the spring and summer. As I got older, I went to the Actioneer Youth Group (now known as Sixers and Junior High Youth Group). I was confirmed at Westminster while in the eighth grade. I attended the Senior High Youth Group and went on the first youth mission trip to Washington, D.C. Now some twenty odd years later, Westminster Presbyterian Church is still a big part of my neighborhood (and my life). I have served as an elder, an usher, a Senior High advisor, and been a part of TNT and The Flock.

In 1947, a small group a people met in a tent to start a church in the growing neighborhood of the Augusta Road area. Sixty-two years later, there have been many changes to Westminster Presbyterian Church as well as the community of faith it serves. The ministry of Westminster may stretch all over Greenville, SC, to the Dominican Republic, to Malawi, Africa and beyond. To me, Westminster will always be a neighborhood church.
