Spring has come again, and with it comes renewal in the natural world. Plants bloom, insects hatch out, and the sun warms us in a way that seems surprising every year.

Easter has just been celebrated by Christians all over the world. It offers all of us an occasion to renew our relationship with God, and by extension with the church and our sisters and brothers in faith. The older I get, the more I appreciate the different paths people may take to reach a personal faith. Easter can also be a time of unease as we navigate the contemporary world of the rational, the logical, the scientific. I find myself drawn to Mark 9:24: “*Lord, I believe, help thou mine unbelief.*”

Doris Betts, a North Carolina novelist and Professor of English at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, deals with questions of faith in her fiction. She has also been an elder in a Presbyterian church near Pittsboro. In an interview I found on the internet, Ms. Betts states she is drawn to that same passage in Mark. “I don’t think modern people can proceed, if they are honest, without the tension reflected in that verse.”

Although she does not consider herself a “Christian author,” several of her novels address religious issues through her characters. In her novel, *Souls Raised From the Dead*, the protagonist, a single father, must endure the illness of his young daughter, as well as disappointments at work. He questions his faith, his family, and himself. Ms. Betts refers to these as “the big questions, the same questions Peter, Mark and James faced.”

I am grateful for a community of faith like Westminster to help me ponder the big question.
