



The tradition of Nine Lessons and Carols began in 1880 at Truro Cathedral in England. This Advent at Westminster, we will celebrate the 58th year of worshipping through the reading of the prophecies and birth narrative from scripture, and singing carols new and old.

A few traditions of our own have developed over these 57 years at Westminster. The service begins with the singing of "Once in Royal David's *City."* The first verse of the hymn has always been sung as a solo, and since 2004, by a 4th grader from Westminster's Children's Choir. This year's soloist is Mary Mac Fairey. The congregation's singing has been led and supported by brass ensemble and the Holtkamp organ. In 2010, an anthem celebrating the 50th occasion of Lessons and Carols was commissioned, and soon after "Still Shining in the Holy Light," by composer Glenn Rudolph was published by MorningStar Music. Following another tradition of King's College, the readers this year will progress from young to older church members, symbolizing the coming of Christ to all ages in all times. The years of this great Advent tradition not only usher us toward the celebration of our Savior's birth, but also remind us that the songs we sing as we worship, the songs of the stories of our faith, carry the ageless and

unending song of God With Us, Emmanuel.
